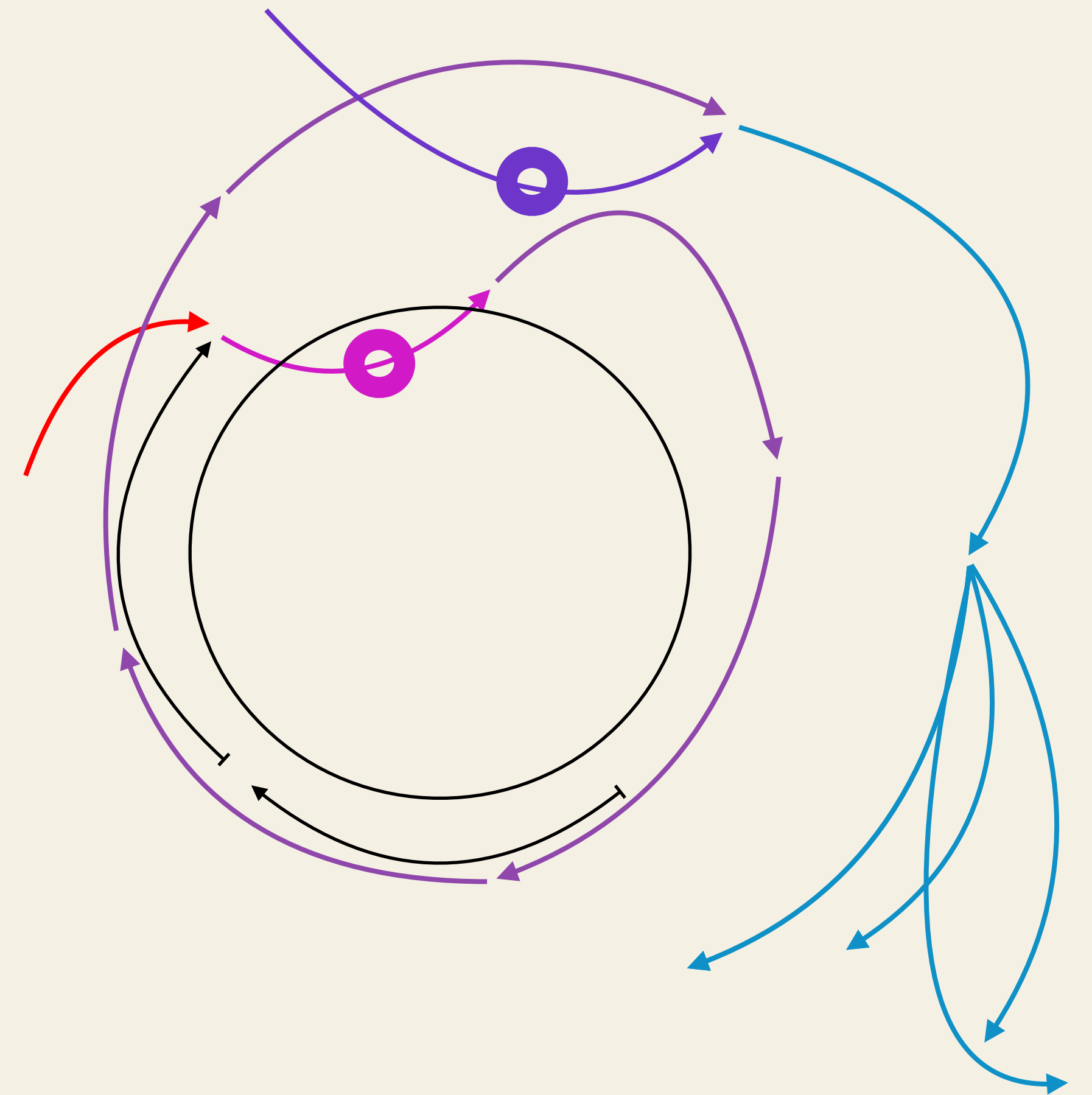

Disagreements

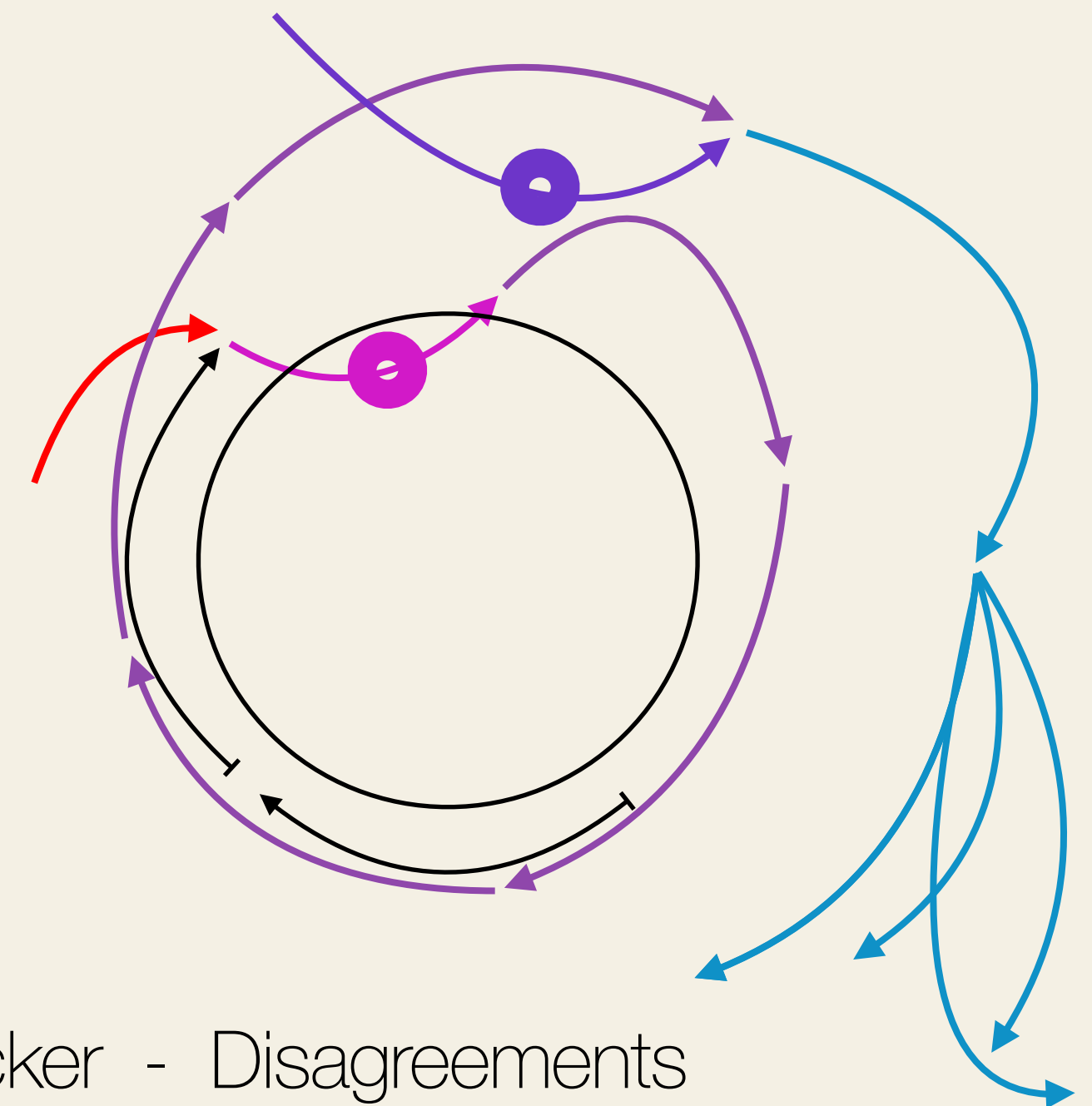
Disagreement: *an argument or a situation in which people do not have the same opinion*

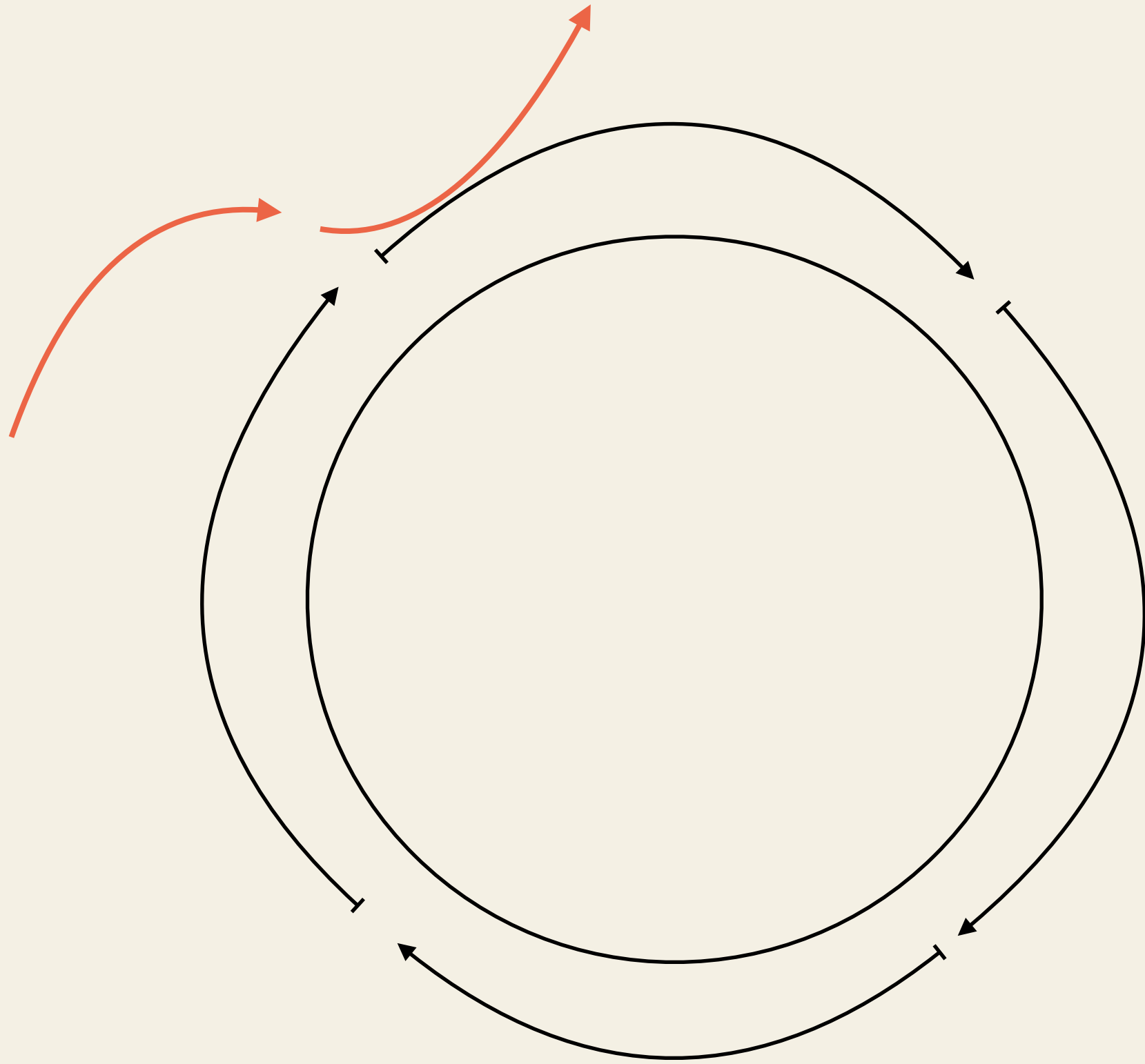
A natural and vital part of all systems and change processes and a generative opportunity for gathering information to grow and move forward with.

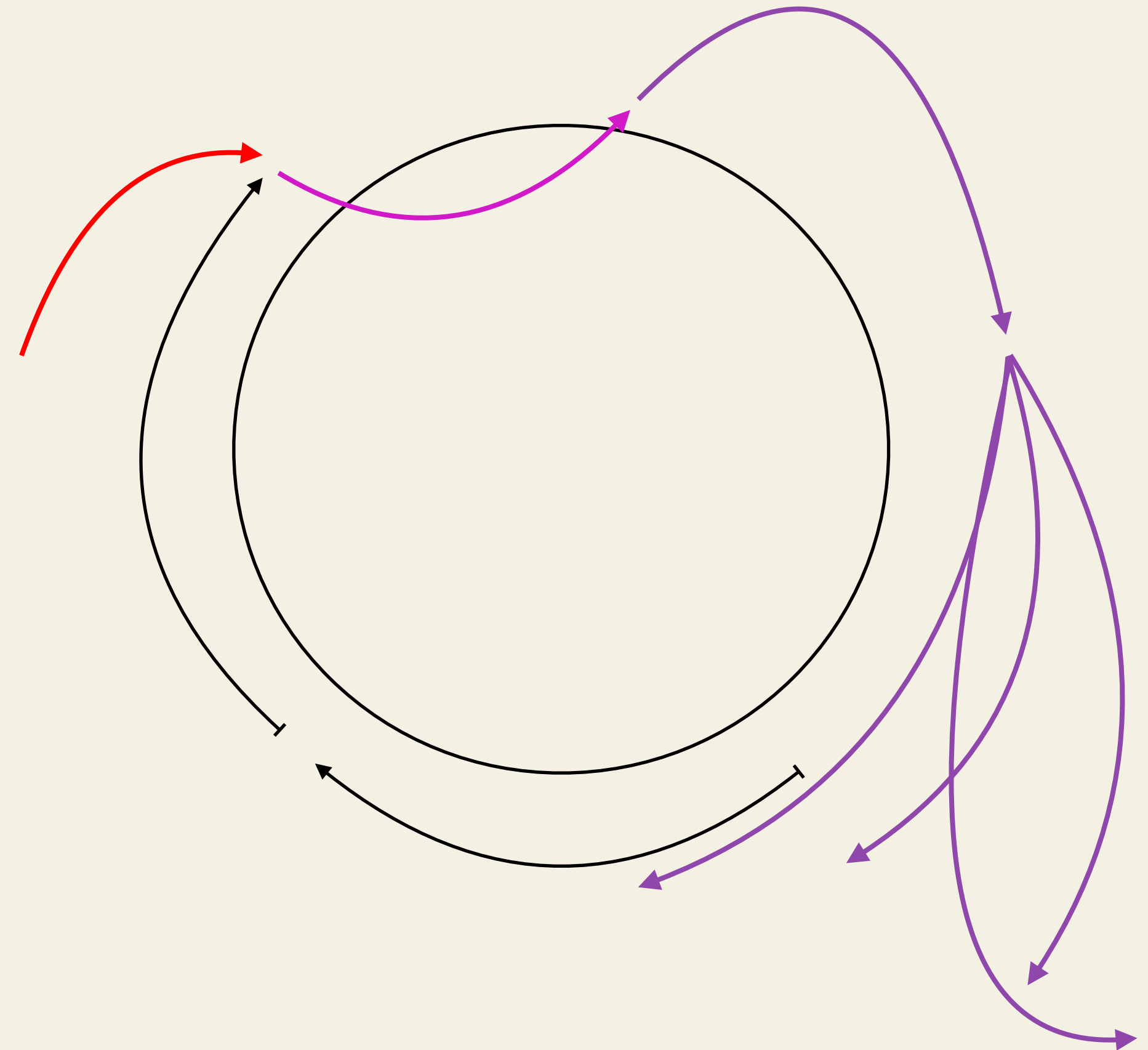

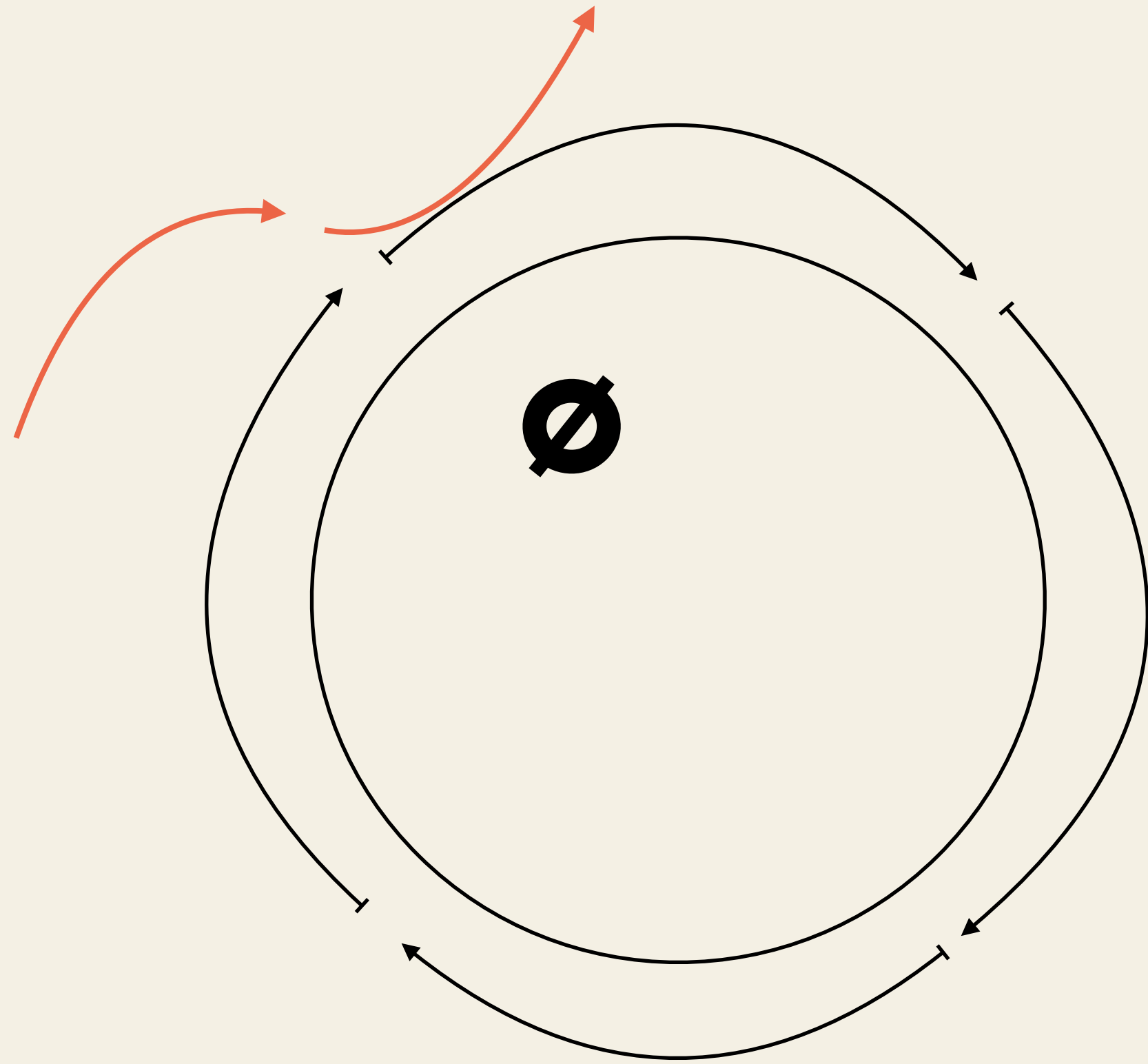


Cycling Disagreement

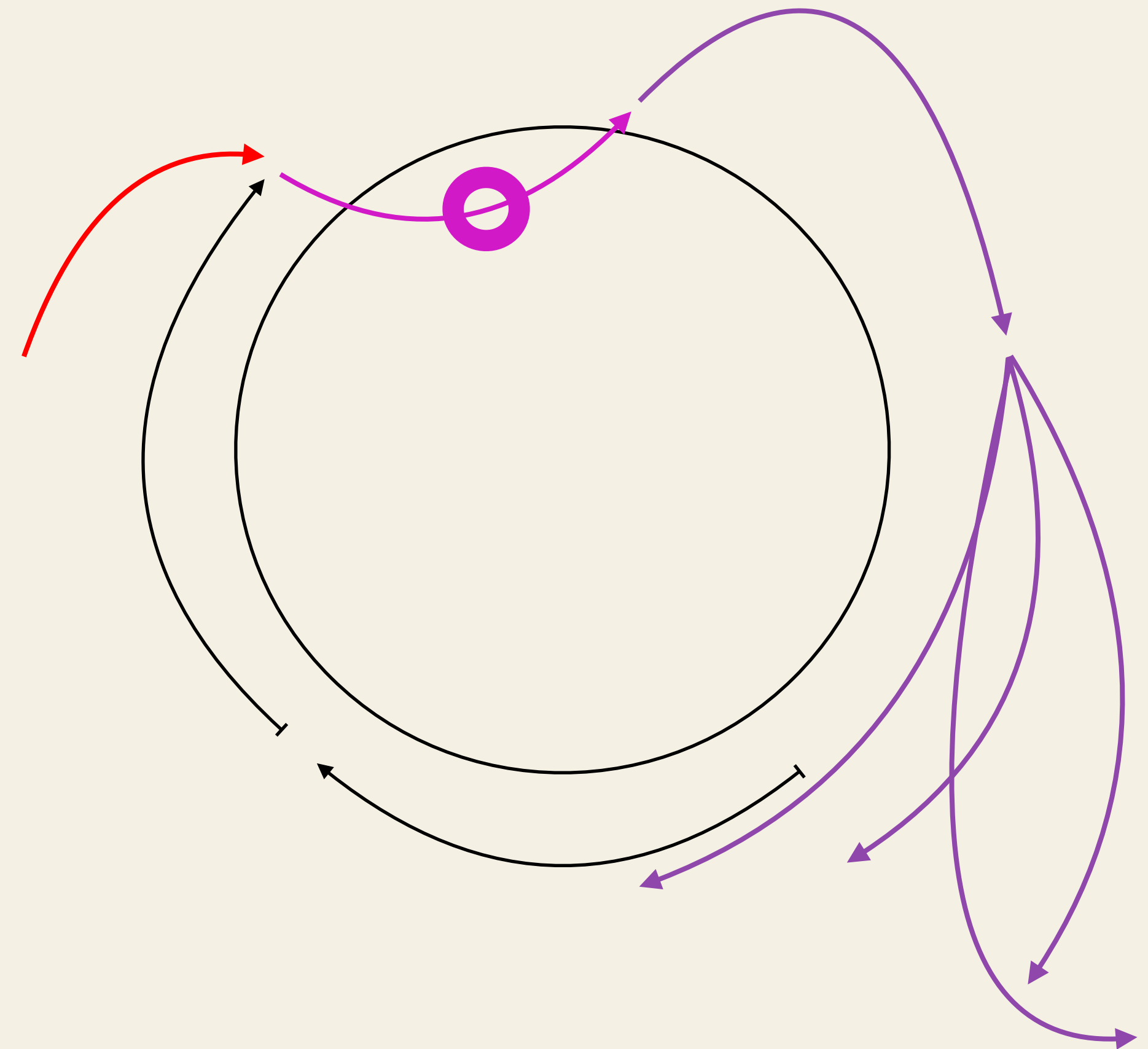


Generative Disagreement

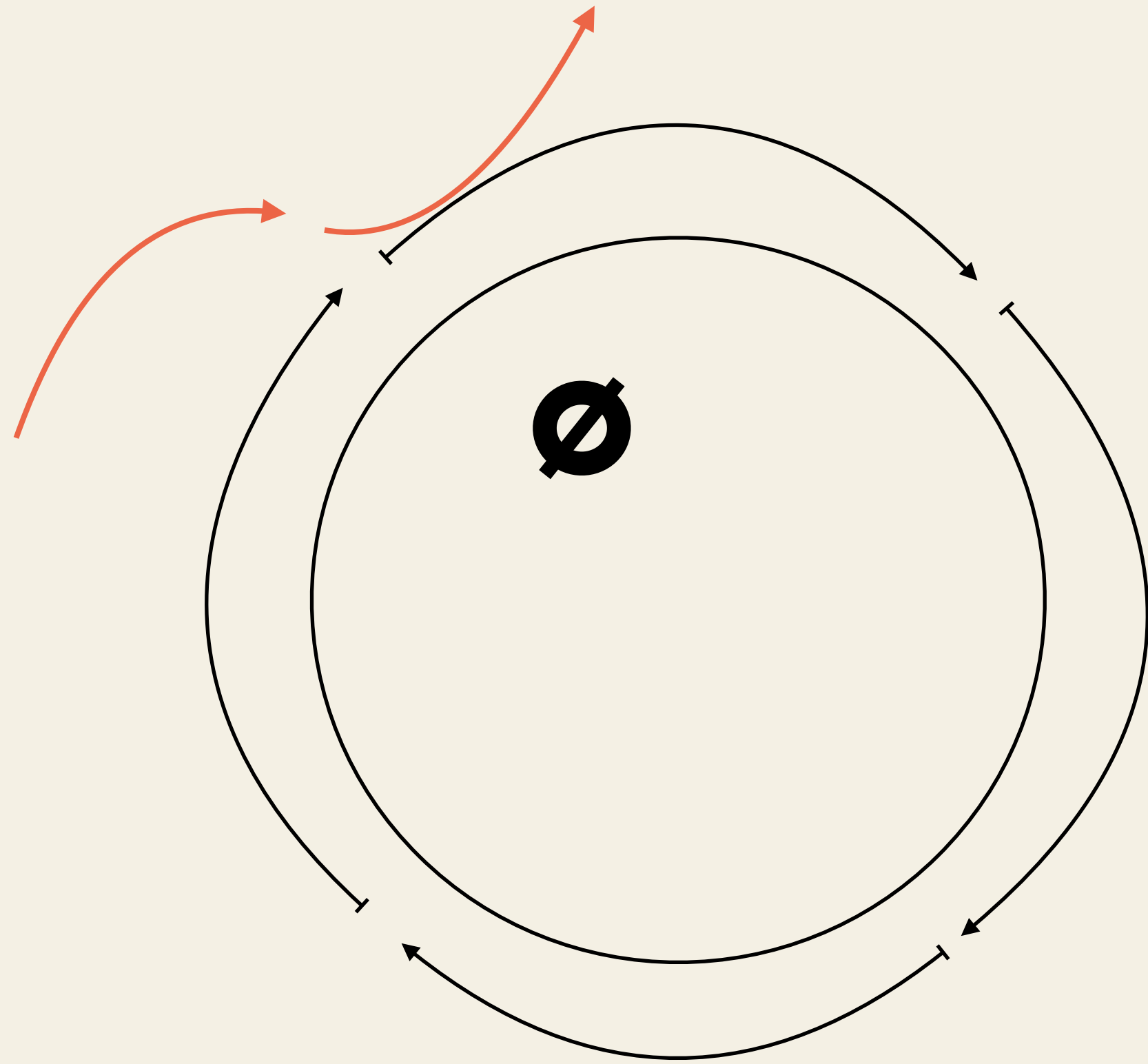

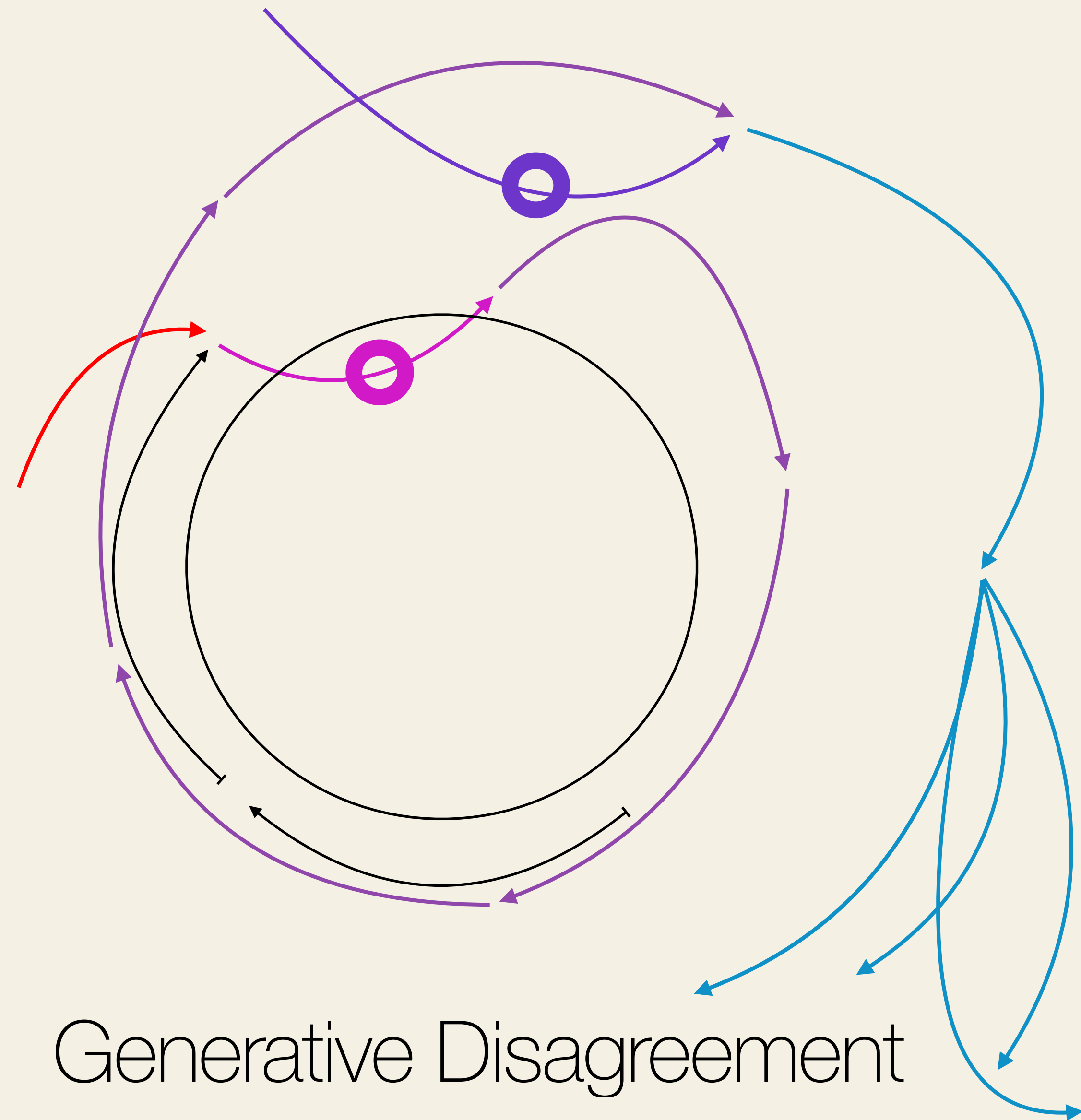
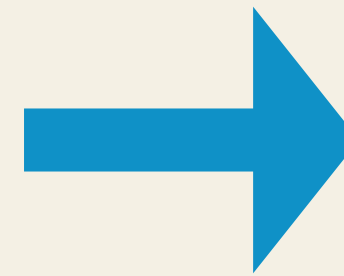
The kinds of information we are most interested in are those that are *less known or unknown* and that *produce some feedback* (reactions, impacts) in the system.
