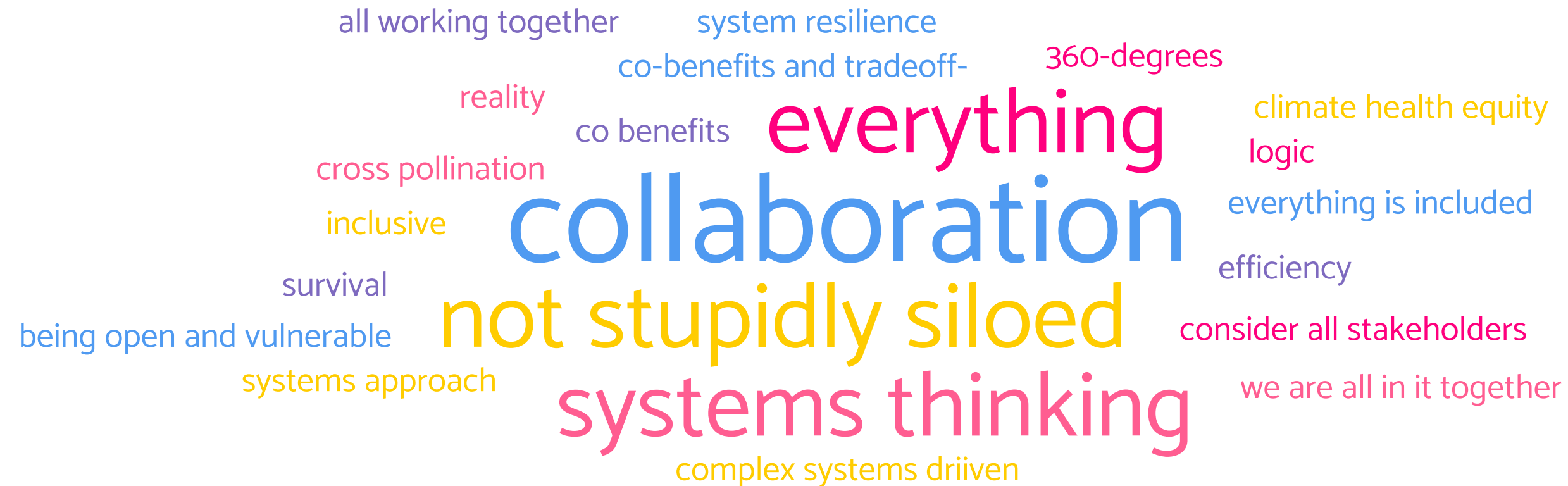


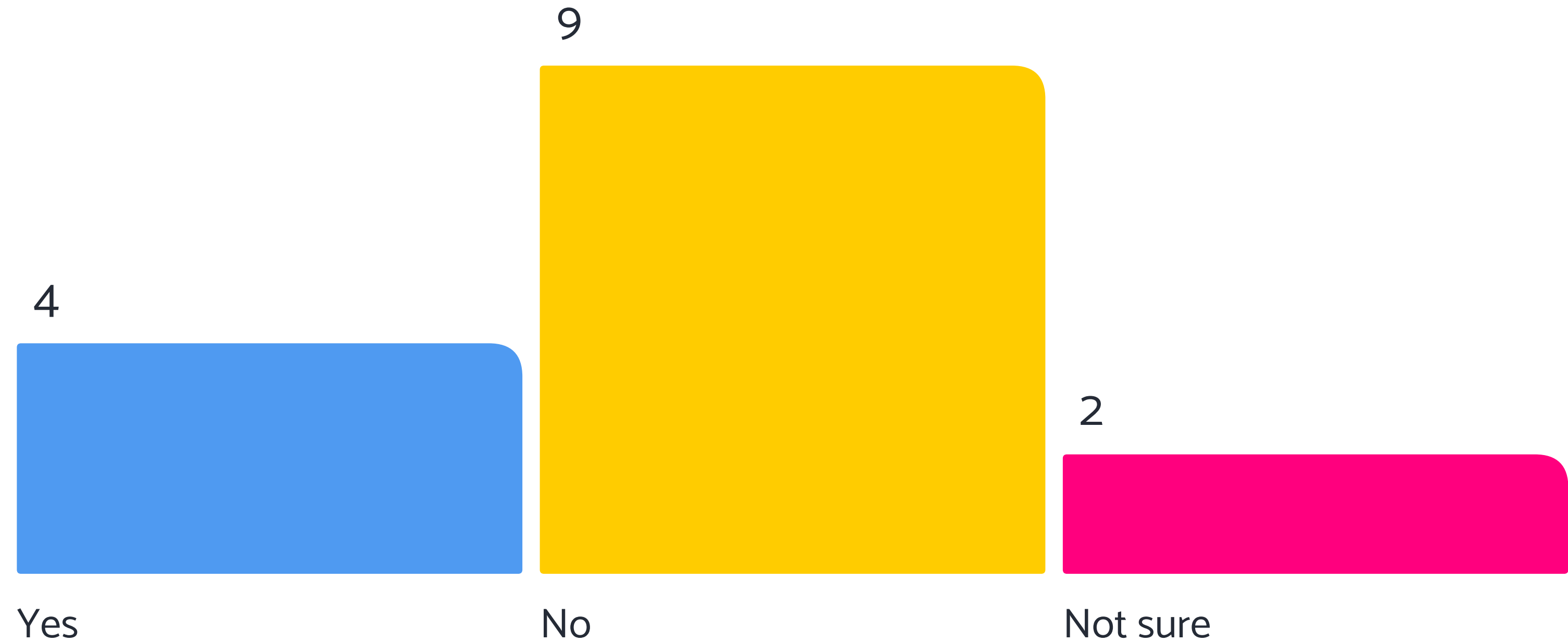
What does holistic, joined up, or full circle adaptation mean to you?
